

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notification is hereby given to the public of the intent of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide assistance to the La Jolla Band of Luiseno Indians, located at 22000 CA-76, Pauma Valley, CA, for the installation of placement of a tuffshed metal container, installation of camera, generator, concrete pad, poles, fencing, and gates. Installation of communication Wifi equipment, radio, and solar panels onto an existing pole.

Because of its location in an undetermined Flood Hazard Area, this facility is susceptible to flooding and storm induced erosion. Under the President's Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, FEMA is required to review opportunities to relocate the facility out of the floodplain or to minimize future damage from flooding. Public comment is invited on possible alternatives to this action and methods to protect the facility.
